FILED BEFORE SARIS, J.

June 28, 2006

All litigants shall follow the Court-wide rules and procedures for Electronic Case Filing. In addition, the parties are required to submit a paper courtesy copy of any electronic document relating to a dispositive motion, opposition, reply or sur-reply, including all exhibits. The courtesy copy should be stamped "Courtesy Copy: **DO NOT SCAN.**"

The term "dispositive motion" includes a motion to dismiss, motion for summary judgment, motion to suppress, motion for preliminary relief, motion for judgment as a matter of law, Daubert motion, and motion in limine.
